



Main Ideas Chain

Collect a piece of round paper for each section or chapter of the book and on each piece do the following:

- Write the name of the title of your book.
- When you have finished reading each chapter, write under the title **FIFTEEN** words that are important to the story you are reading. These words should sum up the main ideas and events in the story.
- Staple each piece of paper to your chain and watch it grow as you read your book.

Example: The Three Little Pigs

three, pigs, left, home, wolf, house, build, straw, sticks, bricks, huff, puff, blow, down, fire
